#### **BUSINESS**

- **1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE** Apologies were received from Councillors Mrs B. Thwaite, K. Devers.
- 2. **DECLARATION OF INTERESTS-** No Councillor had interests to declare.
- 3. Approval of minutes for September/October/November/December Chairman signed these minutes.
- **4. Approval of Terms of Reference-**These were read through and the following amendments were proposed: number to be between 5 & 7 members, Financial Regulations (are they approved if not to be approved at next PC meeting) also "the" to be deleted from between "budget for November/December". Also on contracts should say "prepare all recommendations for Council?" **Following these adjustments agreed we submit to full Council for approval.**

#### 5. EXPENDITURE.

- i) Update on Expenditure for 2018/19 –lists handed out. RFO reports that £2000 for election costs were missed off the budget lists. This makes then total budget (which was approved at full council) of £229,966.24. All budget in order now RFO vired £13000 from Future Projects to LAP so that now in order.
- **ii) Update on 3 year plan** Projects proposed for the next 3 years was as follows: V.C. Project; Fishing pond Electric supply; Cycling; Fairway area upgrade; CCTV system upgrade; Library Garden; Allotments; Rugby Club; Village booklets. Visiting Scheme.
- **iii)** To report on 106 and CIL funding available- Still awaiting quotes etc for Rugby Club work, so cannot proceed with 106 application until these are available. Fairway upgrade should meet this criteria if Rugby club work does not.
- vi) North Yorkshire County Council grass cutting grant for 2019/20 this will be £1,247.39

### 6. MATTERS FOR DISCUSSION.

- I) Update on Boiler problem at White Rose- still nothing from White Rose regarding this. White Rose wanted area over door renewing. RFO had got quote which was for £1,426.33. Agreed that this was only dirty and could be cleaned with UPVC cleaner.
- ii) Update on seating at Fairway area —RFO reports that nothing received yet from Councillor Devers regarding this. Agreed we Propose to full Council that the 2 seats from the Library area be moved to this area.
- iii) Update on Office Refurbishment Just awaiting blinds for this area then all work done.
- **Update on access area at Eversley Park-** RFO had met with builder and he suggests that one complete ramp rather than 2 strips would be a much better option if heavy vehicles are using this access. Two ramps would break up if not "hit" absolutely squarely by vehicles. Quote being sent- will present at PC meeting next week.

## 7. REPORTS

I) Internal Auditors RFO reports that Internal Audit done last Friday all checked and in order. Items brought to attention: Clerk/RFO need Contracts of Employment, Asset Register to be reviewed annually, Insurance Fidelity needs to be increased in line with balances held. Minutes should be sequentially numbered.
